



SNOW REMOVAL

In order for us to provide the best possible winter parking situation for all of our tenants to which we provide parking:

1. Every vehicle must be moved out of the parking lot from 8:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. after each storm - regardless of how much snow falls.
2. If you are in question as to whether or not we will be plowing your parking lot, you can call (207) 761-0832, ext. 2 and our answering service will let you know.
3. If your vehicle is left in the parking lot during the above referenced hours it will be towed at your own expense; No Exceptions.
4. If for some reason you are unable to move your vehicle from the parking lot after a storm, you must call Lynn (ext. 1101) or Rebecca (ext. 1102) at least 24 hours in advance so that we can discuss possible alternatives.
5. The answering service cannot help you if you're unable to move your vehicle, so you must speak to Lynn or Rebecca personally.
6. Messages left on Lynn's or Rebecca's voice mail will not be acceptable. If you haven't spoken to one of them directly your vehicle could still be towed.
7. In some cases whether your vehicle can be moved or not it may still have to be towed, so please park only operable and registered vehicles in the parking lots. Some of our parking lots are difficult or even impossible to plow with vehicles in the way.

With everyone's cooperation we will be able to clear the parking lots during this time frame, but if all vehicles are not removed from the lots by 8:00 a.m. it slows down the whole process and we may not be able to get the lots fully cleared by 2:00 p.m.

Moving your vehicle from the parking lot allows us to plow and sand thoroughly, thereby making the lot safe for our tenants. Should you have any questions and/or concerns, please call (207) 761-0832. Thank you in advance for your anticipated cooperation.
